SUBJ: Annual Report

The International Convention Pin Design Committee is made up of DG Jack Walsh (Y), Lion Luanne Pierson (N), Lion Michael Francoeur (S) and myself.

The duties of the Committee are to design a state pin(s) each year for the International Convention. There are two important results that need to be accomplished with the state pins. First, to provide pins that are of a quality that Lions will want to purchase a set and that Convention attendees will be able to trade in the name of friendship should they choose to do so; and second, to provide income to the International Convention Committee to help support its expenses that include a cocktail party. State pin sales income has traditionally been the largest percentage of total income for the International Convention Committee.

The state pins for the 2021 International Convention in New Delhi were presented to the Council on February 14th and the Committee recommended pins for the regular and prestige pins were approved. The approved designs have been passed on to the International Convention Committee.

The goal of our Committee continues to be that of providing the Lions of Massachusetts with outstanding state pins that they can be proud of when they attend International Conventions in the future.
